INSTRUCTIONS

1. This yatra is purely devotional to enjoy the Bliss of Bhagavan Naama and not a conducted tour for commercial purposes. Each participant is expected to understand this and extend maximum cooperation with the coordinator for the fruitful conduct of the yatra.
2. On visit to religious places it may be necessary to walk approximately 1-2 KMs a day.
3. **Bus seat numbers will be allotted purely on first come first serve basis.**
4. Yatrikas are requested, **NOT TO CARRY ANY VALUABLES DURING THE YATRA.** The co-ordinator will not be held responsible for any loss.
5. Yatrikas are requested to carry a handbag to secure their belongings (esp. eatables, mobile phone, spectacles) in it, to safeguard from monkeys.

6. Yatrikas are requested to stay along with the group, and not venture out on their own during the yatra schedule.
7. Yatrikas are requested to **strictly AVOID going to Yamuna river on their own.**
8. Yatrikas are expected to take care of their health and carry their regular medicines. **The coordinator will not be responsible for yatrika's medical needs.**
9. Food will be arranged from 24th November 2022 morning coffee till 27th November lunch. Food packet will be given for 27th November 2022 dinner.
10. Devotees may bring coins, currency of lower denominations sufficiently, for offering in temples and to rikshaw walas. (i.e. ₹5 ₹10 ₹20 rupees notes or coins).
11. Request the yatrikas to strictly **AVOID GOLD JEWELS** (especially gold chains).
12. Kindly wear the yatra identity card always during the yatra.
13. Request all yatrikas to **strictly maintain dress code** at all times during the yatra. Even **while coming to dining hall**
 - **Saree / Salwar kameez** for women.
 - **Dhoti / Full pants** for men
14. It is the responsibility of the participants to carry with them the original id proof for verification by Railway personnel or Airport authority, while on journey.
